




8. Type https://www.gmail.com into your address bar; then click on the lock icon to the left of it. Make sure it says "verified by Google Inc" before continuing this tutorial
















17. Click on the link that you receive via text message from Coinbase.



18. When prompted, download the Authy application.




19. Once downloaded, open the Authy application on your phone.





20. Now take note of the code you see on your phone, and enter it into the window on your computer before it expires.


If it does, simply enter the new code given instead.



















